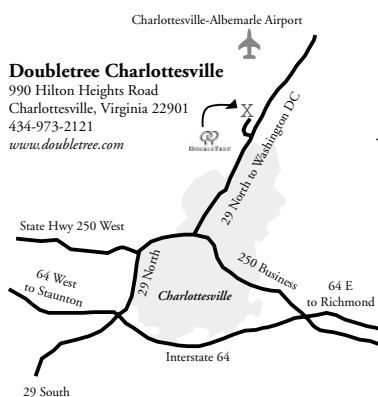
### PrezCon: Transportation

Special in 2005, Jeff “Boomer” Bakalchuck and PrezCon will sponsor a **Carcassone Charity Event**, which will provide games to local children’s hospitals and could set the Guinness Book World Record for the most Carcassone tiles played.

For the first time ever, we will hold an **Advance Event**—Victory in the Pacific, beginning on Tuesday at 9 a.m. We’ll also be running **historical miniatures** events—coordinated by NOVAG’s Walt O’Hara. Plus, don’t miss our **Monster Game** event—returning in 2005!

The **Iron Man Contest** and the **Team Tournament** return in 2005 so you can expect some of the best competition to be found at any con! In addition, we continue **Track** scheduling in 2005. What does that mean? Games in the same track—Tactics, Strategy, Wargames, Parlor, Horsepower, or Euro—are scheduled with minimal overlap. This will allow you to play in all your favorite games! Each Track has its own **Ironman Championship**.

PrezCon delivers a lot of bang for your gaming buck! It’s only \$50 for all 5 days (\$60 at the door) or \$35 Thursday-Friday or Saturday-Sun or \$25 for any one day. (Get a free gift with preregistration.) Visitor’s passes are \$10. They cover the whole weekend for anyone who wants to play an Open Game, visit the Dealers Room, buy at the Auction.

### Advance Event

For the first time ever, PrezCon will be holding an Advance Event—**Victory in the Pacific**, run by Mark Smith. The tournament begins at 9 a.m. on Tues., Feb. 22. It will be a three-round Swiss event, with the final on Wednesday morning. There is **NO CHARGE** to attend the Advance Event if you are registered for the full five days of the convention. The tournament winner will take home a plaque and a t-shirt.



### 12th Annual Game Auction



The 2004 auction was a great success. Bruce Reiff will be doing the auctioneer duties again at PrezCon’s annual auction. Bring your games to sell and your wallet to buy. ### Carcassone Charity Event

Jeff “Boomer” Bakalchuck, Brettspielwelt (the online gaming site), and Rio Grande Games are helping an exciting charity event at PrezCon in 2005. Teams of players will work together over two days to create the largest Carcassone map ever attempted—to beat the record just set in Herne, Germany, players will need to lay more than 5517 tiles. Setting the record will put PrezCon players into the Guinness Book of World Records. As a bonus, Rio Grande will present anyone who participates with a copy of a special Carcassone expansion.

The primary goal of the event is to obtain games for local children’s hospitals, including Shriners and the University of Virginia Medical Center. It’s a worthwhile effort, as the hospitals use games as part of their regular therapy for sick children.

## Team Competition

PrezCon is offering its **9th Annual Team Competition**, based on the format used at WBC. Three-player teams compete for a special Team Competition plaque. Each team member signs up to compete in a different PrezCon tournament, and players score points for the team based on how they place in their chosen tournament. The team with the highest point total wins. If a tie exists, the team with more total competitors in its three chosen tournaments wins. Team members can choose any tournament in which a PrezCon plaque is awarded to the winner.

Teams can sign up for the Team Competition anytime before any team member begins play in his or her team event. (The entire team must be signed up before any member may start an event.) If your team event has multiple heats, you can only sign your team up after tournament heats have begun if you have not played in any earlier heats.
